

FTSE4GOOD AUSTRALIA 30 INDEX

The FTSE4Good Australia 30 Index is designed to give investors access to Australian companies that are actively meeting good standards of practice in corporate responsibility (CR). By working towards various corporate responsibility themes, including environmental management, climate change mitigation, countering bribery, upholding human and labour rights and supply chain labour standards, these companies meet the stringent global criteria required for inclusion in the FTSE4Good universe.

To remain consistent with market expectations and developments in corporate responsibility practice, the FTSE4Good inclusion criteria are enhanced regularly. Criteria are developed using an extensive market consultation process and are approved by an independent committee of experts. A broad range of stakeholders help to shape the criteria including NGOs, governmental bodies, consultants, academics, the investment community and the corporate sector.

MEETING THE NEEDS OF RESPONSIBLE INVESTORS

The FTSE4Good Australia 30 Index inclusion criteria are fully transparent and publicly available. The index can be used in the following ways:

- To enable responsible investors to identify and invest in companies that meet globally recognised corporate responsibility standards
- To provide asset managers with a responsible investment (RI) benchmark and a tool for the development of RI products
- To allow investors to capitalise on the benefits of good corporate responsibility (eg ecoefficiencies, improved brand image etc)
- As an engagement tool to encourage companies to be more responsible

FEATURES

- Companies are assessed against the FTSE4Good inclusion criteria by our research provider, the Ethical Investment Research Service (EIRIS) and their Australian research partner the Centre for Australian Ethical Research (CAER)
- Any company whose weight in the index is greater than 10% will be capped at 10%
- Index governance is overseen by the independent FTSE4Good Policy Committee, made up of leading global responsible investment market practitioners and experts
- Capital and total return indices are available for this index
- The index is calculated in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark, the global standard for industry sector analysis.
- The index is designed for the creation of derivatives, index tracking funds and ETFs
- All FTSE4Good fund licensing revenues go to UNICEF to help children around the world
