

FTSE Bursa Malaysia Palm Oil Plantation Index

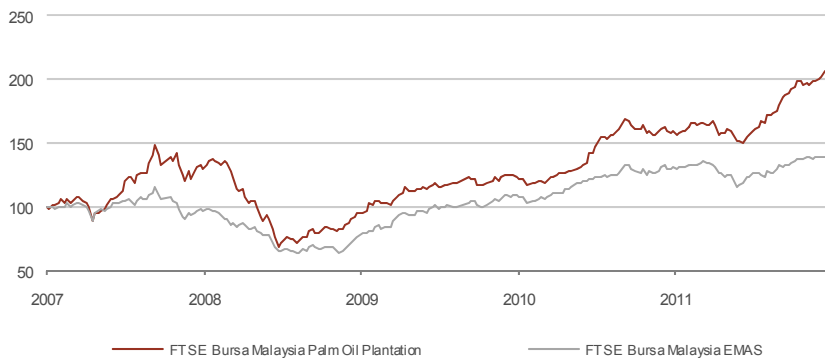

The FTSE Bursa Malaysia Palm Oil Plantation Index has been designed to provide easy access to investors who wish to participate in Malaysia's burgeoning palm oil industry. This benchmark index comprises palm oil related companies from the underlying FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index and aims to capture the performance of companies that earn a substantial proportion of their revenue from palm oil activities. Palm oil activities include production, ownership or operation of palm oil and palm oil plantations.

Screening Highlights

- Eligible constituents must be a member of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index at the semi-annual review.
- To be included in the index a company is required to have greater than 30% of total revenue from palm oil related activities.
- Existing constituents will no longer be eligible if total revenue from palm oil related activities falls below 20%.

FEATURES

Coverage

Companies in FTSE Bursa Malaysia EMAS Index that earn a substantial proportion of their revenue from palm oil activities.

Objective

The index has been designed as a performance benchmark. Stocks are capped at 10% on a quarterly basis to avoid over-concentration of any one stock.

Investability

Stocks are free-float weighted to ensure that only the investable opportunity set is included within the indices.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Transparency

Freely available index rules are overseen by an independent committee of leading market professionals.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time and end-of-day.

Global Sector Classification

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
