

# FTSEurofirst Supersector Indices

The FTSEurofirst Supersector Indices provide investors with 18 highly tradable pan-European sector indices. The indices are derived from the FTSEurofirst 300 Index and are available in pan-European and Eurozone only form.

The indices are calculated in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark, the global standard for industry sector analysis. The design of the Supersector tier applied to the blue chip companies in the FTSEurofirst 300 Index creates a set of indices that are an ideal tool for European investment products.

The FTSEurofirst 300 Index covers 93.3% of the FTSE Developed Europe Index.

## The FTSEurofirst Supersector Indices

Supersector	Description
FTSEurofirst Automobiles & Parts Index	Covers companies involved in the manufacture of cars, tyres and new or replacement parts. Excludes vehicles used for commercial or recreational purposes.
FTSEurofirst Banks Index	Contains banks whose business is primarily retail.
FTSEurofirst Basic Resources Index	Comprises companies involved in the extraction and basic processing of natural resources other than oil and gas. For example coal, metal ore (including the production of basic aluminium, iron and steel products), precious metals and gemstones. This sector also includes the forestry and paper industry.
FTSEurofirst Chemicals Index	Encompasses companies that produce and distribute either commodity or finished chemical products.
FTSEurofirst Construction & Materials Index	Includes companies engaged in the construction of buildings and infrastructure, and the producers of materials and services used by this sector.
FTSEurofirst Financial Services Index	Comprises companies involved in corporate banking and investment services, including real estate activities.
FTSEurofirst Food & Beverages Index	Encompasses those companies involved in the food industry, from crop growing and livestock farming to production and packing. This includes those manufacturing and distributing beverages, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic, but excludes retailers.
FTSEurofirst Health Care Index	Includes companies involved in the provision of health care, pharmaceuticals, medical equipment and medical supplies.
FTSEurofirst Industrial Goods & Services Index	Contains companies involved in the manufacturing industries, including service providers to these companies. Includes engineering, aerospace and defence, containers and packaging companies, electrical equipment manufacturers and commercial transport services.
FTSEurofirst Insurance Index	Encompasses companies that offer insurance, life insurance or reinsurance, including brokers or agents.
FTSEurofirst Media Index	Constituents are companies that produce TV, radio and filmed entertainment. These include media agencies and both print and electronic publishing.
FTSEurofirst Oil & Gas Index	Covers companies engaged in the exploration, production and distribution of oil and gas, including suppliers of equipment and services to the industry.
FTSEurofirst Personal & Household Goods Index	Constituents include companies engaged in the production of durable and non-durable personal and household products, including furnishings, clothing, home electrical goods, recreational equipment and tobacco products.
FTSEurofirst Retail Index	Comprises companies that provide retail consumer goods and services, including food and drugs.
FTSEurofirst Technology Index	Constituents offer computer and telecommunications hardware and related equipment, software and services, including internet access.
FTSEurofirst Telecommunications Index	Includes providers of fixed-line and mobile telephone services. Excludes manufacturers and suppliers of telecommunications equipment.
FTSEurofirst Travel & Leisure Index	Encompasses companies providing leisure services, such as hotels, theme parks, restaurants, bars, cinemas and consumer travel services (airlines and auto rentals).
FTSEurofirst Utilities Index	Covers companies that provide electricity, gas and water services.

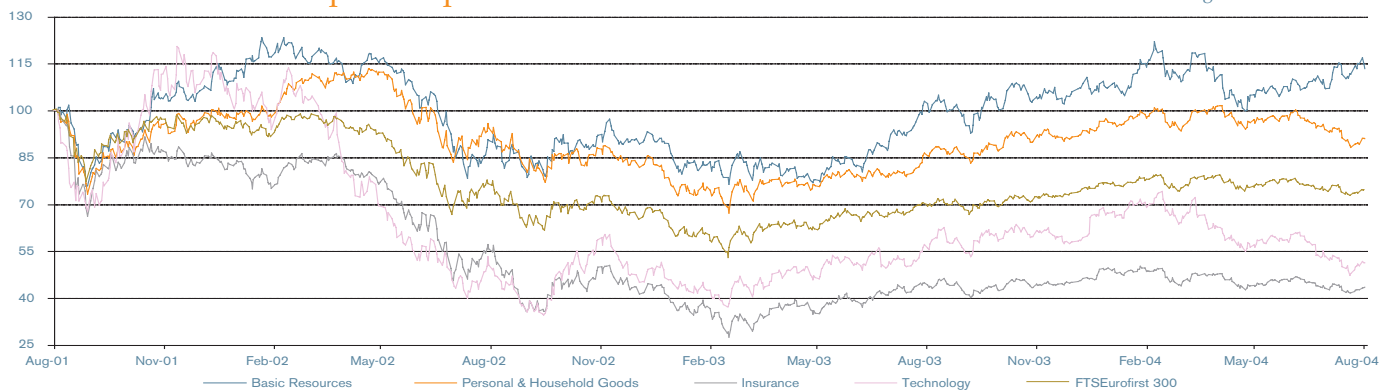

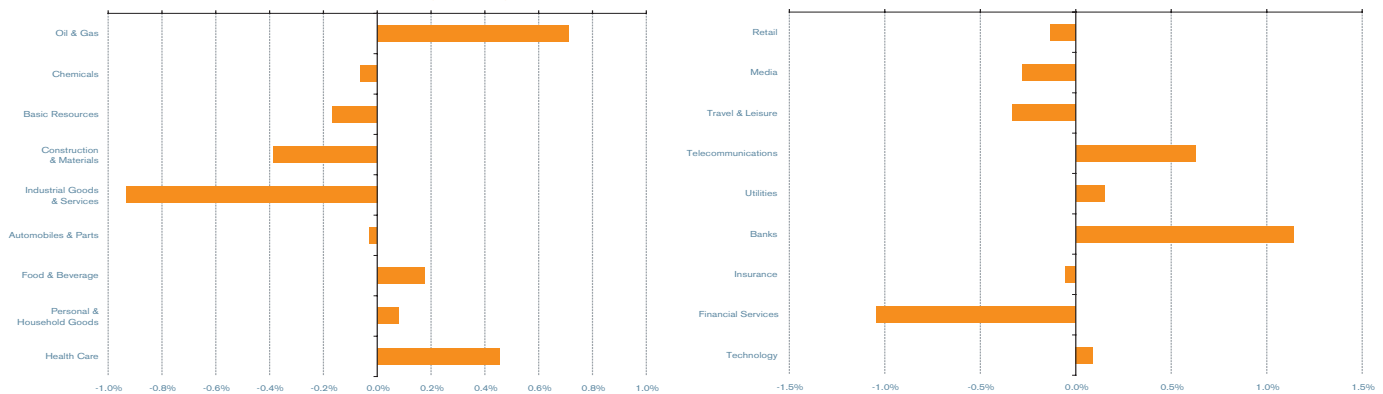
