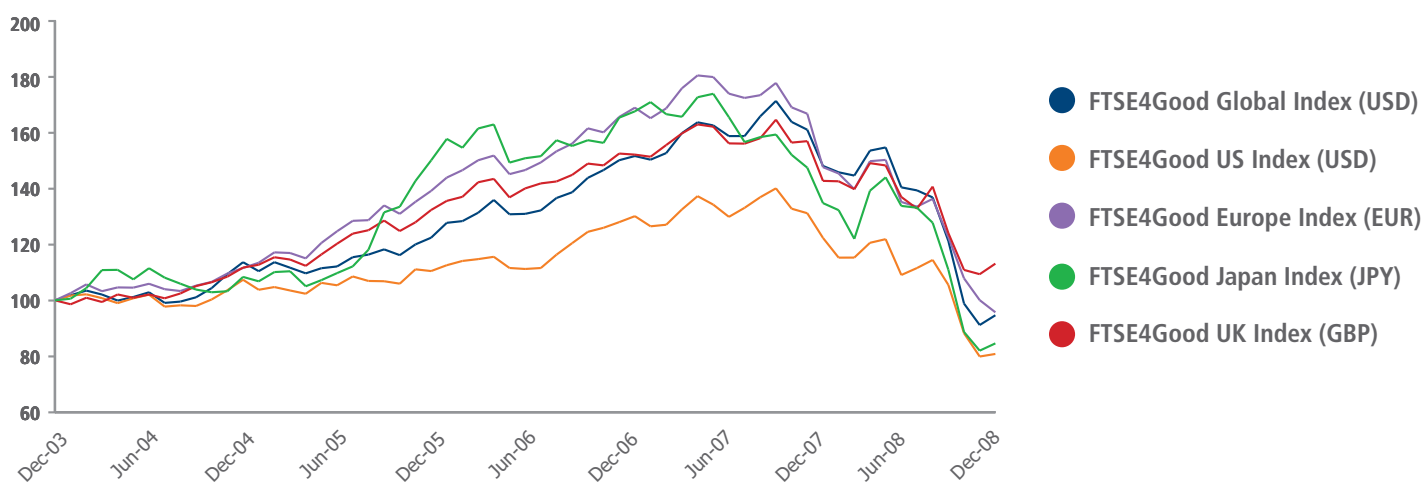

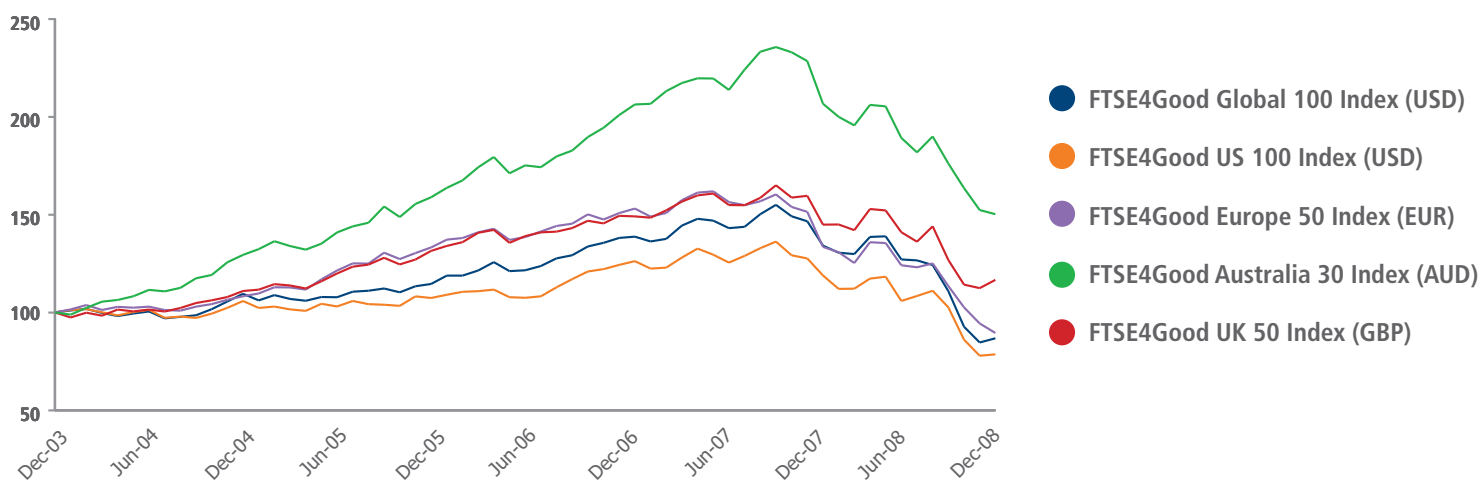

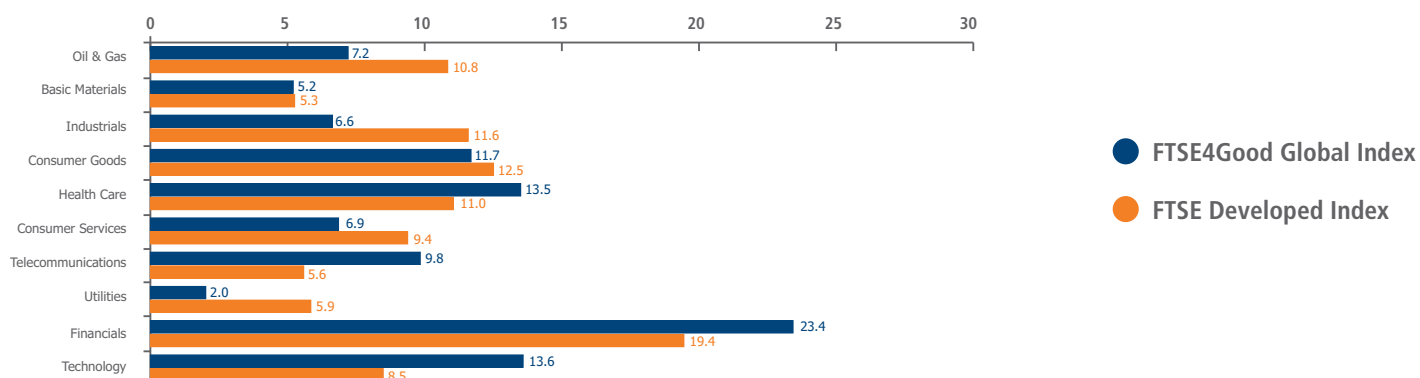

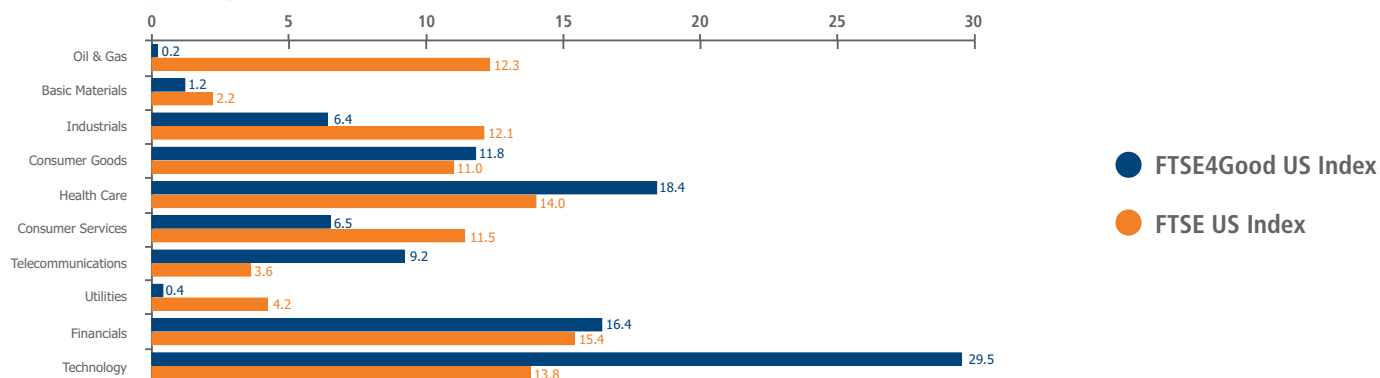

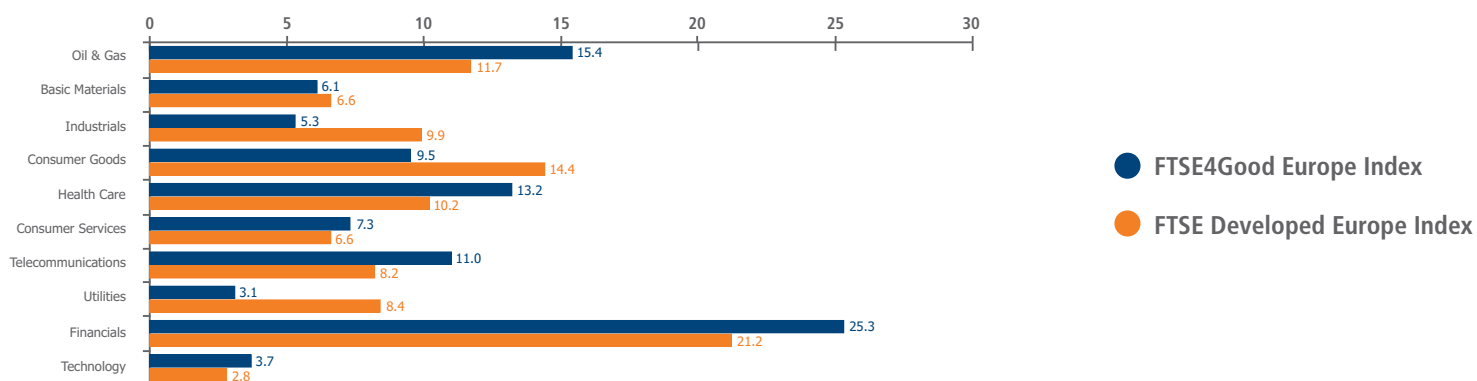
Global Industry Weights (%)



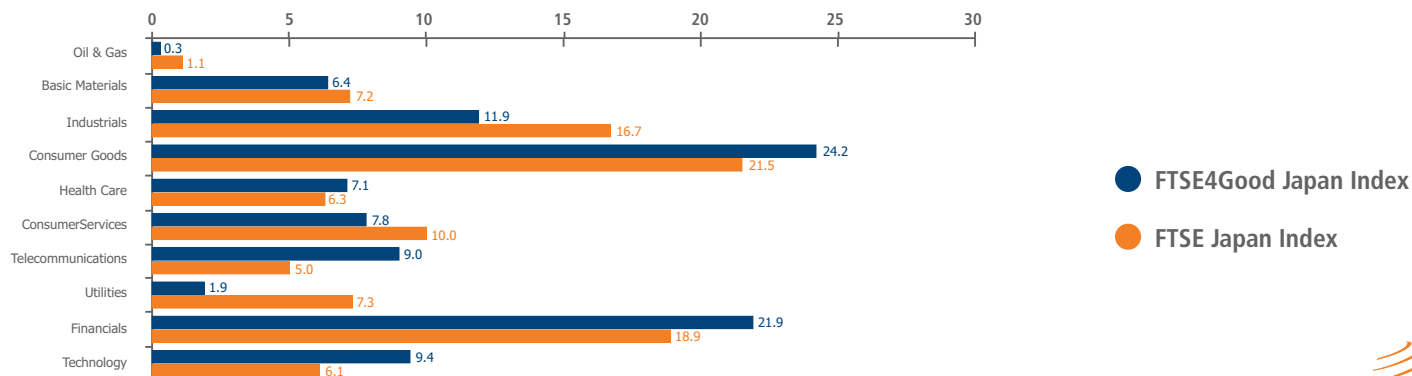
US Industry Weights (%)



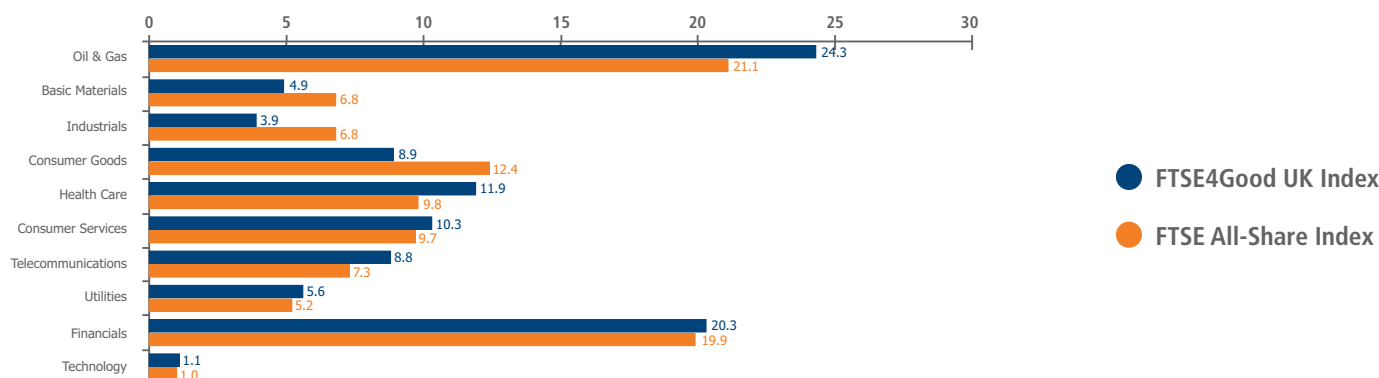
Europe Industry Weights (%)



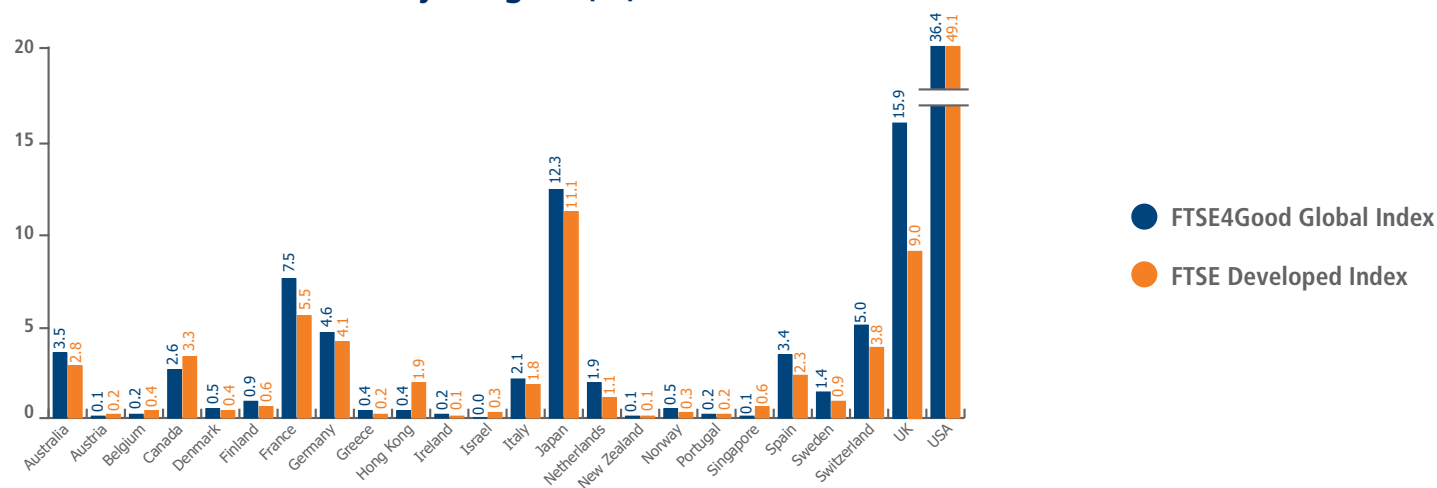
Japan Industry Weights (%)
